

## ESC CHALLENGE AIR RIFLE SOLO – AIR PISTOL SOLO

## A. Description of the format

1) Solo is an individual event for athletes competing in the ESC Champions League. Each participating Team athlete will compete as individual athlete in Solo event. They will compete in the competition in two (2) stages, Semifinals and Medal Match. The winner will be the best athlete in Air Rifle and Air Pistol.

## **<u>B.</u>** Selection of participating athletes

- 2) The participating athletes will be selected from Teams participating in the European Champions League.
- 3) Each participating nation has right for four (4) participating athletes in each discipline: two (2) Male and two (2) Female.
- 4) In Semifinals athletes of the same gender compete among themselves.
- 5) In the Semifinal stage the athletes will be ranked for start list by ranking of their Team. The athletes from first (1<sup>st</sup>) Team will be ranked first (1<sup>st</sup>), etc.
- 6) On the day before the competitions the coach of each Team will notify RTS Jury which athletes will be position 1 and 2 at the competitions (M1, M2 and W1, W2).

Semifinals rifle:

- ARSFM1: 4<sup>th</sup> M1, 2<sup>nd</sup>M1, 1<sup>st</sup>M1, 3<sup>rd</sup>M1
- ARSFM2: 4<sup>th</sup>M2, 2<sup>nd</sup>M2, 1<sup>st</sup>M2, 3<sup>rd</sup>M2
- ARSFW1: 4<sup>th</sup> W1, 2<sup>nd</sup>W1, 1<sup>st</sup>W1, 3<sup>rd</sup>W1
- ARSFW2: 4<sup>th</sup>W2, 2<sup>nd</sup>W2, 1<sup>st</sup>W2, 3<sup>rd</sup>W2

Semifinals pistol:

- APSFM1: 4<sup>th</sup> M1, 2<sup>nd</sup>M1, 1<sup>st</sup>M1, 3<sup>rd</sup>M1
- APSFM2: 4<sup>th</sup>M2, 2<sup>nd</sup>M2, 1<sup>st</sup>M2, 3<sup>rd</sup>M2
- APSFW1: 4<sup>th</sup> W1, 2<sup>nd</sup>W1, 1<sup>st</sup>W1, 3<sup>rd</sup>W1
- APSFW2: 4<sup>th</sup>W2, 2<sup>nd</sup>W2, 1<sup>st</sup>W2, 3<sup>rd</sup>W2
- 7) In Medal Match the winners of discipline Semifinals will compete together (Men + Women)
  - ARMM: W2 (ARSFW2), W1 (ARSFW1), M1 (ARSFM1), M2 (ARSFM2)
  - APMM: W2 (APSFW2), W1 (APSFW1), M1 (APSFM1), M2 (APSFM1)

## <u>C.</u> <u>Competition rules</u>

- 1) In Semifinals and Medal Matches HIT or MISS system will be used:
  - a. Air Rifle HIT value is 10,3 or higher.
  - b. Air Pistol HIT value is 9,8 or higher.
- 2) Presentation of Athletes before each stage separately during walk in.
- 3) Take your position thirty (30) s
- 4) Preparation and sighting time: Five (5) minutes.
- 5) <u>Semifinals</u>
  - Four (4) three (3) shoots series in one hundred fifty (150) s time limit
  - All athletes start from 0. Athlete score is number of hits.
  - After two (2) series 4<sup>th</sup> place is decided.
  - After three (3) series 3<sup>rd</sup> place is decided.
  - After four (4) series 2<sup>nd</sup> place and winner are decided.
  - In Case of Tie to decide third or fourth place, tie will be broken by Ranking of the team. Athlete from lower ranked team will be eliminated.
  - In Case of Tie to decide first and second place, tied athletes will fire single shoot off shot on HIT/MIS system in time limit of fifty (50) s until tie is broken.
  - Winners of each semifinal will progress to Medal Match.
- 6) <u>Medal Match</u>
  - ARMM: W2 (ARSFW2), W1 (ARSFW1), M1 (ARSFM1), M2 (ARSFM2)
  - APMM: W2 (APSFW2), W1 (APSFW1), M1 (APSFM1), M2 (APSFM1)
    - Five (5) five (5) shoots series in two hundred fifty (250) s time limit each.
  - All athletes start from 0. Athlete score is number of hits.
  - After three (3) series 4<sup>th</sup> place is decided.
  - After four (4) series 3<sup>rd</sup> place is decided.
  - After five (5) series 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> places are decided.
  - Each coach has one (1) time out in time limit of thirty (30) s.
  - In Case of Tie to decide lowest ranking place. tied athletes will fire single shoot off shot on HIT/MIS system in time limit of fifty (50) s until tie is broken.
